Nancy Whitehair Ribble Memorial Scholarship

The Nancy Whitehair Ribble Memorial Scholarship is given in honor of a long-time educator whose exemplary career as a teacher spanned nearly forty years in several Kansas communities including Salina.

Mrs. Ribble began teaching in the Salina school district in 1962 at the Shilling Air Force Base School. She also taught in the Canton-Galva school district, the Solomon school district, and the Salina Catholic Diocese at St. Mary's Grade School. She returned to USD 305 in 1978. During this time, she completed her Master's degree in Special Education and began teaching special needs students at Roosevelt-Lincoln Middle School and continued teaching in the new Lakewood Middle School until her death.

Mrs. Ribble's devoted work with students was exemplified by her multiple selections as Renaissance teacher of the month. Her family has established the scholarship in her honor to assist Lakewood Middle teachers who wish to improve themselves through continuing education and training.

The amount of the Nancy Whitehair Ribble Memorial Scholarship Committee is \$250, awarded annually to a current member of the Lakewood Middle School teaching staff. The funds allow the recipient to take additional college hours or to attend a conference or any event that will help to improve themselves as an educator.

A selection committee will name the recipient on an objective and nondiscriminatory basis. The committee will notify the Salina Education Foundation of the name of the chosen recipient no later than April 15.

Applicants must be recommended by their administrator. Applicants must have persistence, good character, and must be committed to the field of education. The recipient will provide the SEF with an invoice or statement from the university or program he/she wishes to attend, and a check will be issued to the teacher/college or program.
