Pam McIntyre Teacher Scholarship

Pam McIntyre was the executive director of the Salina Education Foundation from 1996 until her retirement in 2020. The SEF's board of trustees has established this scholarship to honor Pam's legacy by helping a USD 305 teacher or counselor achieve his/her post graduate degree.

Criteria:

- These one-time \$1,000 scholarships support USD 305 teachers who are working toward an advanced degree in their teaching discipline or in the field of school counseling.
- The scholarship may be used for any accredited graduate degree program.
- Any certified USD 305 teacher is eligible to apply. The scholarship will be awarded each calendar year on an objective and nondiscriminatory basis.

Application Due Date: April 1, annually

A completed application must be submitted to the Salina Education Foundation, Box 797, by April 1 of each calendar year. A committee consisting of Pam McIntyre or her proxy, the Executive Director of the Salina Education Foundation, and the USD 305 Executive Director of School Improvement will select scholarship recipients.

Upon notification of selection by the committee, the Salina Education Foundation will announce the recipient(s). Once selected, the recipient will provide the SEF with an invoice or statement from the college, program, or university he/she wishes to attend, and funds will be issued to the teacher/college, program, or university. The scholarship recipient will be notified immediately following the selection process.

Eligibility

One \$1,000 scholarship may be awarded each calendar year on an objective and nondiscriminatory basis. All applicants must be currently teaching in Salina Public Schools.
