## Miss N Teacher Scholarship

The *Miss N Teacher Scholarship* honors Anne Nettleton, a beloved artist and teacher. The scholarship recognizes a current USD 305 art teacher who wishes to further his/her education.

Anne Nettleton taught elementary art in Salina USD 305 for 37 years from 1973 until her retirement in 2010. In 1994, she was honored as Kansas Master Teacher by Emporia State University. She was a dedicated champion of the teaching profession, serving as Salina NEA President, Negotiating Team Member, and representative to many committees. She believed continuing professional and personal development was important and always sought to represent the interests of teachers and children, both in the district and in the community. Anne attributed her willingness to attempt difficult tasks, her determination to succeed, and her positive attitude toward life and learning to three key women in her life: her mother who gave her a love of life, her first art teacher who told her she could paint, and a college professor who prepared her and others into an "art army" whose mission was to save the world through art education.

A completed application must be submitted to the Salina Education Foundation by April 1 of each calendar year. A committee consisting of one representative of Anne Nettleton's family, a USD 305 Art Teacher, and an artist from the community will select the recipient.

Upon notification of selection by the committee, the Salina Education Foundation will announce the recipient. Once selected, the recipient will provide the SEF with an invoice or statement from the art conference, convention, course, or workshop, and funds will be issued to the teacher. The scholarship recipient will be notified immediately following the selection process.

### **Eligibility**

One \$500 scholarship may be awarded each calendar year on an objective and nondiscriminatory basis. All applicants must be a current art teacher in Salina Public Schools.
